Miracle Power for Your Desperate Hour

I was studying my word last night, sitting on the back porch, and then Debbie had to go and do something so I said, "Well, I think I'll go up and get me something to eat". It looked like it was going to rain – and I'm preaching on Faith this morning, to speak the Word, to prophecy into your life things that will come to pass – and as I was driving up there all of the sudden the Lord said "speak that Word go ahead and speak that Word to it" and I said, "we can't take anymore rain", I said "Lord, let those clouds go away don't let it rain", and it didn't. And how do you get surprised when you speak the Word and it comes to pass? And then I came back and I sat on the back porch and I turned on the ball game and I watched the ball game a few minutes and the Lord said you need to turn off the TV; you need to finish up your sermon. So I said Well, Lord just let my team make one more touchdown, so they made one more touchdown and I said, I was like a little kid, I said, do it again, ha, ha, but then I turned off the television and I got to studying. And then I got up early this morning and I said, "I'm going to go over to the church and I'm going to pray". And I came over to the church – I actually preached my sermon over at the church this morning, amen? And I was crying out to the Lord, I started crying and I was in His presence and His presence filled this temple while I was worshipping Him.

This morning I want to preach out of Mark 5:35 about miracles, miracles for your desperate hour. It says, do not be afraid only believe. How many of you would agree with me that Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today, and forever more? In other words He still saves people, He still heals people, He still meets their needs, I didn't say their wants, I said their needs. In Matthew 6:25, it says "therefore I say to you do not worry about your life, what you will eat or drink, nor your body what you will wear. Is not life more than food, and the body more than clothing?" How many of you know there will be desperate moments in your time, in your life, that can be described as a desperate hour? What I mean by desperate hour is, you're going through trials and tribulations, problems in your life, and it feels like time has run out. Have you ever felt like time has run out on you? Every option has been exhausted. You feel like you are between a rock and a hard place and there's no where to go. In the natural, defeat seems inevitable. It could be in your health, it could be in your marriage, your family or your finances. Have you ever been there? Has anybody been there? I know I have. Maybe you're going through that now. And how many of you know that when you reach that desperate hour, you need more than the world has to offer? You don't need your five senses – what you can see, what you can touch, what you can hear – but what you need is the power that raised Christ from the dead, that now lives in you as believers. Are you a Believer this morning? That same power lives in you this morning, but it needs to become reality to you, because greater is He that is in me than he that is in the world. Amen? And the only way you can manifest that power is to stand on the Word of God. As Debbie says, Peter walked on the Word, he did not walk on the water, and when the Lord commanded him to get out of the boat, he walked on the water so this morning let's stand on His Word, amen, and walk on that Word this morning. In our lives the Word of God is not only given for inspiration,

but it's also given to show us other people's lives as examples. Why examples? So we can receive what they did.

So this morning I want to show you, through the Word of God a man that was going through a desperate hour, so please get your Bibles out and turn to Mark chapter five and see if you would agree with me that this man Jairus was living in a desperate hour? In the same way Jairus received his miracle power is the same way you will find yours. So it says in Mark 5:35, while he was still speaking, some came from the ruler of the synagogue's house who said "your daughter is dead, why trouble the teacher any further. As soon as Jesus heard the word that was spoken, He said to the ruler of the synagogue do not be afraid only believe. How He permitted no one to follow Him except Peter, James, and John the brother of James. Then He came to the house of the ruler of the synagogue and saw a commotion and those who wept and wailed loudly. When He came in He said to them, why make this commotion and weep? The child is not dead but is sleeping and they ridiculed him when He had put them all out side He took the Father and the Mother of the child and those who were with him and entered where the child was lying. Then He took the child by the hand and said to her, little girl I say to you, arise", Talitha Kum is what He said. That's the exact words that He spoke out of His mouth. When I read that word, Talitha Kum, I don't know something chill bumps come on me, that was the exact words Jesus spoke. There's not too many place in the Bible that they use the exact Words that Jesus spoke, but that was the exact words that He spoke.

In your life you will receive bad reports that will bring you to a desperate hour. The Bible says the ruler of the synagogue had an only daughter that was sick with fever that was ravaging her twelve year old body, and the Bible says she was getting weaker and weaker. I know how Jairus felt. When your child is sick you feel like you're helpless, you're useless and she was lying at the point of death. I can picture Jairus trying to do everything in his natural he can do, and we are suppose to as mothers and fathers to do all we can do. Then I believe that Jairus, something rose up inside of him and said, his faith rose up inside of him and said, let's go and find Jesus. How many times have we said, after trying everything we could in the natural, let's go find Jesus? Sometimes we use Jesus as the last hope. He's supposed to be our hope, but He's supposed to be our first hope, not our last hope. So that's why we need to make it our first priority to study His Word and spend time with Him in prayer. Do you spend time with Him in prayer? What you put in your spirit is what you will get out of it. When that desperate hour comes in your life, some of us wait till things go bad, till all our resources run out we try to find Jesus. Then we try to bargain with Him. If you will only do this or do that Jesus, I will keep your commandments. How many times have you tried to bargain with Jesus? He said, keep my commandment, love me first. Sorry it doesn't work that way. How it works is through investing time in His presence, making deposits rather than withdrawals all the time. Yes, God is a loving God, but the Bible says, He is also an all knowing God. He knows where you are spending your time, so when you spend time and you have a problem, you can come boldly to His throne, instead of crawling up like a dog when he has done something wrong. So we need to spend time with Him. We need to make deposits. Jairus found Jesus that day, but the Bible said, there was a great crowd that day, and if you will remember that was the same day that the lady with the issue of blood, and

she had it for twelve years, pushed through the crowd and touched the hem of His garment and she was healed. So sometimes you have to push through the crowd to receive your miracle, you have to push through the circumstances in your life to receive that miracle. I'm going to have to say something that might not sound just right, but I'm sure when I say it you'll know what I mean. Have you ever been in service where people are getting healed, delivered and set free from all kinds of things? Have you ever been there? Or people testifying how God met their financial need and you feel left out? And the devil whispers into your soulish realm, and says, "they're getting their healing, what about you?" What I'm trying to say is, sometimes it can almost be a torment to you. When everybody is getting their miracle and you're left out, but at that point you're suppose to cast down that thought it says; so this woman is happy with the issue of blood because she has received her miracle. But I will give Jairus the benefit of the doubt, I'm sure, his heart was saying, oh Praise the Lord, I'm glad she got her miracle, but at the same time he was saying but we need to go Jesus, we need to get to my house. My daughter was at the point of death when I left her, and it's been some time and time is running out. At that very moment someone walks up behind him and whispers into his ear, hoping only Jairus would hear it.

In a desperate hour the voice of reason says, it's time to give up. Mark 5:35 says and you've read it already, "your daughter is dead, why trouble the teacher?" When you reach that desperate hour and you have come to the end of yourself it is the moment that you get a sudden revelation of human limitation. Yes, you get a sudden revelation of human limitation. If you get nothing else from this sermon, get this because I am an eye witness to this that God is always in control. And God has a design in allowing you to come into a desperate hour that He might receive the glory. I want you to know this there is nothing that will ever come into your life that surprises God. It might surprise you, but it never surprises God. Faith and grace will save you, but you know what? Faith won't prevent troubles from coming into your life. I'd like to say it does but it won't. Faith will not prevent troubles from coming into your life. You know reason is a useful thing. There are certain aspects of life in which reason serves us well, but you have to remember reason works in the realm of the natural limitations, but radical faith, real faith works in the Spirit realm. In other words, real faith is very often, if not always, unreasonable. What do I mean by unreasonable?

If you could turn over to Hebrews 11, I won't ask you to turn there I'll just give you an example. And if you read about those men of faith, and those women of faith you would see what I mean. They were not reasonable men and women. There was not one of them that was reasonable. Think about this, Enoch's going to walk with a God that he can not see. That is unreasonable to the natural man. Noah's going to build a boat on dry land, why, because rain is coming. What's rain? They had never seen rain, water that was going to fall out of the sky. That's unreasonable to the natural eye. Abraham at the age of 75 had all kinds of land and cattle where he was. He was a rich person, the Bible says he was rich in all things, and gets up one morning and says we're going to move. "Where are we going to move, Abraham?" the men said to him. "I don't know, God has spoken to me and said to a land that He will show me." What land? "I don't know, He has not told me it's name". Do you think that sounds reasonable to the people of Ur? They thought

Abraham had gone slap dab out of his mind. Look at his wife Sarah, at 90 years old she's saying, we're holding on for a child. My gosh, she couldn't even have a child at 25 years old, and now she's holding on at 90! That's unreasonable to the natural man. Moses an 80 year old man, this is a good one, Moses an 80 year old man goes back to confront the most powerful military nation on the earth by himself with just what? A stick! That's unreasonable. David is going to take on a giant with a child's toy a slingshot. He's going to fight a battle hardened warrior with just a sling shot, that's unreasonable. Do you think Gideon's plan sounds reasonable? Do you think Joshua had a reasonable plan for conquering Jericho? What did he say? Oh, we'll just march around a couple of times and blow the trumpet to see what happens. That is not reasonable, that is unreasonable. So when you face your limitation, when you face your desperate hour don't forget the God factor because it says in Luke 18:27, because things that are impossible with men are what? Possible with God!

So when you need a Desperate Hour Miracle, you need to get out of your head, your senses, what you can see, touch, taste, feel, and get into the Spirit. Reason lives in your head and faith in your spirit. It is said a lot of people don't know the difference between the two. There is a difference until you learn the difference between your head and your spirit you're going to be a confused individual, and you're going to make mistakes, you're going to think this, and your head's going to think that and your spirit's going to think this. But in a Desperate Hour you better get out of your head and into the Spirit. And the only way you can do that is to start by being broken, like I was this morning. I came before the Lord and I was broken before Him. I wept before Him, amen? And prayer and pressing into His presence will bring brokenness, because through prayer you form what? You form a relationship with God. Your spirit becomes sensitive to His Spirit. You know when you meet somebody, like when Debbie and I met, I couldn't wait to get over there every night because I wanted to find out more and more about her. I won't go there, ha, ha, that made me nervous. Hallelujah, thank you Lord, thank you for a sense of humor.

Jesus is with you in your Desperate Hour and He hears every bad report. Let me say that again. Jesus is with you in your Desperate Hour and He hears every bad report. Mark 5:36, says as soon as Jesus heard the word that was spoken, as soon as Jesus heard the word that was spoken. You're not alone in your Desperate Hour, Matthew 28:20 says, Lo, I am with you always. Hebrews 13:5 says, I will never leave you or what? Forsake you. What Jesus is saying, is He will personally be involved with you in your Desperate Hour, when your doctor says, cancer, when your accountant says, bankruptcy, when your spouse says divorce, Jesus stands right there and He hears every bad report and He will be with you in that Desperate Hour, amen. As soon as bad reports come in Jesus has something to say to you. Mark 5:36 says, Do not be afraid, only believe. So as soon as Jesus heard the word, that was spoken, He said. You know in the Greek it doesn't read that way, in the Greek it reads, He says, not He said, because that's the way we construct our sentences and it makes it appropriate for English language, but He said is a past tense, He says is a presence tense. Literally it reads, as soon as Jesus heard the word, He says, I like that, don't you, He says, because you know why I like that? God is a present tense God, He's a right now God, He is the Great I Am, He is not I use to be or I will be some

day. He is I Am right now. He is what you need Him to be right now. He says to the ruler of the synagogue in Luke 8:50, He says an account of the same story, He adds one word when He says it in Luke. When Jesus heard it He answered saying. How many of you know that Jesus is the answer today, or Jesus has the answer today? One of the most important things in life you will ever learn is how to answer the bad reports or situations in your life. Man is that a true statement. Proverbs 15:23 says, A man has joy by the answer of his mouth. What does the Bible say? Life and Death are spoken out of the mouth. Most people think life comes from circumstances. People think if they've got a raise they're happy, and if they lose their job, their depressed or sad. Man does not have joy by what comes to him, man has joy by what he says comes from him. Man has joy by the answer of his mouth. Just five verses later in Proverbs 15:28 it says, the heart of the righteous study how to answer; so you have to study how to answer or you won't know the answer, well, you'll see.

I have a lot of notes this morning and Debbie always asks me, why do write so many things down? Why don't you just make it simple and write a simple outline and go by that? You know what, Debbie said if I ever come with a question come with a verse, and I come with the answer this morning, ha, amen, and you know what that answer is it's found in Proverbs 15:28. So I can study how to answer, amen? So I can sit down and study and go over and over it, until this word gets into my spirit, and that's the way I do it, amen? Because six verses later it says, in Proverbs 16:1, the preparation of the heart belongs to man. So the preparation belongs to you, but the answer of the tongue is from the Lord. So like Debbie says if you watch TV all the time and you don't study, and trials and tribulations come or sickness comes, what is going to come out of your mouth if you watch TV all the time? The words of Bart Simpson or the words of Jesus? What should come out of your mouth is the Word of God. So when hard times come, the preparation of the heart belongs to you, but the answer of the tongue will belong to the Lord. You know what, Debbie studies and studies all the time but I can see now through my studying why she does it. I understand that when she goes to Ukraine, she has to be prepared. It's in her heart to study the Word, but it's the tongue of the Lord speaking into those peoples live. She does not want it to be her. She wants it to be the Lord. She has to make preparation by yielding and studying His Word. Amen.

In your Desperate Hour, Jesus says, Do not be afraid, only believe. He says to the ruler of the synagogue, do not be afraid, only believe. What Jesus says to you in your Desperate Hour will most of the time be a simple word. He won't try to lay a bunch theology on you. He says do not be afraid, only believe. That is pretty simple, that's just a few words. Listen closely, in your Desperate Hour the greatest enemy, do you know what the greatest enemy is in your Desperate Hour, the spirit of fear. In your Desperate Hour your greatest enemy is not the situation. When they say cancer, your greatest enemy is not cancer, it's the fear of cancer. When they say bankruptcy, your greatest fear is not the financial problem, your greatest enemy is the spirit of fear. Oh my, what are we going to do? We're going to lose the house, we're going to lose the car. Suddenly fear is in you. Fear is a spirit, because it says in 2 Timothy 1:7, let's turn over there... For God has not given us a spirit of fear, but of power and of a sound mind. Yes, amen, sound mind, self-control, you're supposed to have self-control. Fear is a spirit. It is not an emotion, it

effects your emotions. It will manifest in your emotions. But fear is not an emotion, fear is a spirit. The spirit of fear is not from God, guess who it's from? The living God is a faith God and He has established a faith covenant with a faith people. Fear is the opposite of faith. Unbelief is not the opposite of faith, unbelief is the neutral of faith. It is the absence of faith. Fear is the opposite of faith. Fear is negative, fear is from the Devil. So in your Desperate Hour, your greatest enemy is fear. The fight of faith is to stay out of fear. In your Desperate Hours surround yourself with people who have faith. Mark 5:37 says, and He permitted no one to follow Him except Peter, James, and John. In other words not all of the disciples went. Can I go Lord? No, Bartholomew, sit down. Thomas, Can I go? I doubt it... (Ha Ha). How many of you want to be one of the few that Jesus can use in a Desperate Hour? Don't you want to be that one? Hallelujah. You don't want Jesus to say I love you, but sit down I can't use you. I want Him to say get up and get in the game, Steve.

Now, many people have the capacity for sympathy, wouldn't you say, but few have the real capacity for faith in a Desperate Hour. They'll sympathize with you, but man, when it comes down to believing or comes down to the hard stuff, they run on you. And if all you want is comfort, sympathy is fine, that will do if that's all you want. That is all you're going to get. But if you want a miracle, you need faith. If you have already given up, that is fine, get to sympathizers, but if you are holding out for a miracle, you better get the believers, you better get the faith people on the job. The people that pray, the people that walk on the Word and believe in what the word says. You need to get them, because sympathy can be the enemy of faith, it has good intentions but it can become soulish, it is natural, it's natural to have feelings. It is not supernatural. Sympathy focuses on the problem and what it does is it establishes you and the problem as one. Faith focuses on the Word. In your Desperate Hour, you need people of faith, not sympathizers.

The force of fear will attack your senses. It says in Mark 5:38, "then he came to the house of the ruler of the synagogue and saw a great commotion and those who wept and wailed loudly". That is something He heard, He saw people upset, He heard people wailing and weeping. The sense realm, is the realm where the Devil will attack you, and that is the only realm, he can hit you in. Remember, he is a whisper, he can only whisper into your soulish realm, your five senses. He attacks you in your soulish realm which are your senses, like I said, and when he does, if you don't speak the Word, your faith will falter. You have to get out of your sense realm and get into the Word, the spirit realm. 2 Corinthians 5:7 says, We walk by faith, not by sight. We don't walk by senses, we don't walk by feeling. Once fear has entered into the senses, into your mind, in emotions, it is difficult to operate in faith. What Satan wants to do is get into our faith and get us into an emotional state. The first thing is not to let him get there, and the second, don't get into the emotional thing. I'm sure you will feel things, and it's alright to feel things and have feelings, we all do. It would be inhuman not to. To be emotional but don't let your emotions get the best of you. Take over, like Debbie says, don't let your emotions rule you. You're not supposed to let them rule you. You need to remember that everything perceived by the senses belong to the temporal realm, and everything in the temporal realm is what? Subject to change. 2 Corinthians 4:18 says, while we do not look to the things which are seen, but at things which are not seen. For the things which are seen are

temporal, but the things which are not seen are eternal. One of the definitions for temporal is subject to change. That is everything that can be detected by the five senses, physical senses, if you can see or hear it or you can smell it, or if you can touch it, or you can taste it, that's the five senses; then it belongs to the temporal realm and it is subject to change, your soulish realm. But, we look at the things which are eternal. How do you look at the things that are eternal? You look at His Word, because it says in Isaiah 40:8, The grass withers and the flowers fade, but the Word of God stands forever. Now, 1 Peter 2:24, for example, by His stripes I am healed. People say, well, you don't look healed. Well, we do not look at the things, I do not look at the things, which are seen; but I look at the things which are not seen. For the things that are seen are temporal, but the things that are not seen are eternal. What I'm trying to do...it's already done in the heavenlies, but I'm trying to get it to manifest in the natural, in me. It has to become a complete reality to you. What you say in a Desperate Hour, determines the outcome. Mark 5:39, when he came in He said. Your tongue has the power of life or death, Proverbs 18:21. If you say to this mountain be removed and cast into the sea, it will be done, Matthew 21:21. It says in James 3:4, your tongue determines whether your life is sent into a shipwreck or guided into a safe harbor. When it is all said and done, how many of you speak to the mountain in your life? Like I spoke to those rain clouds yesterday? Sometimes we say well, I feel funny talking to situations or talking to objects. You think that's unreasonable? You do it all the time. How many think you do it all the time? You do it all the time, you talk to objects all the time. I can hear Brian in there, "this stupid computer, why won't it work, why won't it work?" So how many of you speak to your computer or you speak to your car? All of the sudden you're riding through the Wal-Mart parking lot and you see a guy with his hood up and he's going "this stupid car won't...Bah, bah, bah, bah, bah". You don't think anything of it, you think that's natural, you don't say, oh my God, he's speaking to his car? What you really think is when you speak positive. Am I speaking to anyone this morning? Why don't you say to your car and your computer, "you're a blessing, you run all the time, you never tear up, you get me to my destination and to the things of God", amen? Why don't we speak that?

So if you don't have a heart, it says, "full of faith", just don't say anything. Proverbs 6:2, you are ensnared by the words of your mouth. You're taken by the words of your mouth. In a Desperate Hour, Jesus will say, "your miracle is not dead, it is simply sleeping". Mark 5:39 says, why make this commotion and weep, the child is not dead, but sleeping. In your Desperate Hour, you must dare to prophecy. What is prophesy? Declaring the Word of the Lord in any situation. You don't have to be in church on Sunday to prophecy, did you know that? You don't have to be in front of a crowd to prophecy. You can prophecy on Thursday afternoon, mowing the grass, and when you are washing the clothes. You can prophecy on Thursday afternoon over the children. They're called of God, they are a blessing, they are not going to be on drugs, they are going to be fulfilled, they have a destiny in Jesus. I prophecy my seed will be great in the earth. You know, God commanded Ezekiel to prophecy in Israel in the Desperate Hour. It says in Ezekiel 37:1-5, "the hand of the Lord came upon me and brought me out in the Spirit of the Lord and set me down in the mist of the valley and it was full of dry bones", that's Israel, it could be us, dry bones, "then it caused me to pass by them all around and behold there were very many in the open valley and indeed they were very dry and He said to me, son of man, can these dry bones live? So I answered", I like this part — "Oh Lord you know". Jimmy always says to me, I use to know a gentleman that said, his son would ask him a question, and he would say, God only knows. "Again He said to me prophecy to these bones and say to them, Oh dry bones, hear the Word of the Lord. Thus, says the Lord God to these bones, surely I will cause breath to enter into you and you shall live". In the valley of dead dreams, and failed visions, you must dare to prophecy. Prophesy is not a primary predictive, it is a cost effective, amen? It causes things to change. At that time, Israel had been taken away into captivity. Jerusalem was in ruins and the Israel people were all slaves in Babylon when Ezekiel had the vision of that situation. Amos 3:7, "surely the Lord God does nothing unless He reveals His secret to His servants and prophets". God has given authority like we sang about this morning to the sons of men. Who are the sons of men? That's us, according to prophecy, so He needs to get you to prophecy before He can show up and do that miracle in your life. You need to speak forth His Word and believe it, and declare it in the earth.

In your Desperate Hour, faith will always be ridiculed. Mark 5:40 and they ridiculed Him. In a Desperate Hour real faith will be ridiculed. Yes, they were upset their 12 year old daughter was dead, and the people in the house most likely were their friends and their relatives, and they were grieved by what was happening. Their hearts were broken and yours would be too. And they were hurting for that 12 year old little girl. Jesus shows up and says, she is not dead, she is just sleeping. So people will ridicule you when you speak forth the words sometimes. They probably said, "who is this guy? He's crazy, we can see she's dead". I can hear Jesus saying, you know what I think He said to them? "You can't handle the truth", amen?

Sympathy will turn to ridicule when confronted with real faith, because sympathy belongs to the natural man. Faith belongs to the spirit man. The Bible says they laughed him down; they tried to shut Jesus' faith down by laughing at Him. Have you ever had unbelief laugh in your face? Just keep speaking faith because you're about to wake up your miracle. In the end laughter belongs to faith, not to the devil. In the middle of the battle the devil might laugh, but when Isaac was born, who had the last laugh? Isaac whose name means what? "laughter", belongs to Abraham who is the faith man, and we are the seed of Abraham. Abraham gives birth to Isaac, Abraham gives birth to laughter, not the devil. The old saying goes, he who laughs last, laughs the best and the loudest! In your Desperate Hour, you have to fight to create an atmosphere of faith. How many of you know that? Mark 5:40 says, "but when He put them out", see you have to put doubt out, right? But that's all the Bible says about that. It leaves it to your imagination. I remember what He did in the temple. Do you remember what He did in the temple? He found a whip. Oh, yes. But when He got to Jairus' house they laughed at Him, He put them out. Why did He put them out? Because you have to create an atmosphere of faith. How do you do that, create an atmosphere of faith? Like I said, put doubt out. How do you create an atmosphere in your Desperate Hour? You need to get the Bible out, you need to read the Word, listen to worship tapes, praise, pray with the faith people. Create a faithful atmosphere.

In your Desperate Hour Jesus will speak three times. How many of you know that He will speak three times? First, He will speak to your troubled heart, what did He say, "do not be afraid, only believe?" Two, He will speak to your doubting mind, "she is not dead, but sleeping". He will speak to your impossible situation, "little girl, I say arise". Amen. In your Desperate Hour, don't listen to the bad reporters and the weeping wailers. Listen to the voice of Jesus. The only way to release Desperate Power in your Desperate Hour is to say what Jesus said, "Little girl, I say arise". You need to let your faith harmonize with the resonation of what God said in His Word.

In closing, I found something very interesting. The particle physicist has told us now at the subatomic level what they have found. They have not found substance, they have found sound. Everything that is in the matter world at its basic level is comprised not of subject but of sound. What is sound? Those particle Physicists, they know a lot of things and I know they know more than I do about that, but I know something they don't know, where sound come from. It is a resonation of God's voice who spoke everything into existence and it is still speaking today. I'm saying harmonize, come into agreement with what God says, "little girl arise". I say to you arise. Speak to what is dead in your life, your business, your marriage, your family, your finances your health your emotions. Speak to them today the Word of God; declare the Word of God over your children, and your situations. Jesus has the keys to your miracle, and He said, He has given them to you. So it's up to you to unlock that door allowing Him to speak to your heart.

I like to watch NASCAR racing and you know those drivers that race around the track, they'll come in and they'll tell the crew chief what's wrong with the car. You know what? And today, I've spoken the word and if it's ministered to you today, you need to make changes in your life. You need to make time to pray, I made time to pray this week. I use to say, oh man, I've got to do this, I've got to do that, I've got to go out and trim the trees, I've got to do this. You know what I spent time in the word this week and I got everything done. Amen, God gave me the strength, He gave me supernatural strength.

Too many times, we look at things that are seen, but He tells us to look at things eternal, those things which are not seen. They are the things that last. The things of the soulish realm, like He said they wither like the grass and fade like the flowers, they are here today and gone tomorrow, but trust in the Lord today, He's eternal, He will bring you through your Desperate Hour, amen, He will speak to you in your Desperate Hour, Hallelujah!
